

# Charges for Markyate Village Hall

1st April 2009 to 31st March 2010

The **Markyate Village Hall** was completed in October 1990 and is licensed for Music and Dancing providing an ideal venue for social and business functions. The Hall is managed by a delegated Management Sub - Committee of the Markyate Parish Council.

**Entrance Lobby and Foyer** provides an attractive entry to the premise leading to the main hall, cloakrooms and wheelchair w.c. A small lobby adjoining the foyer provides access to The Jones Room and kitchen.

**Main Hall** 50'x24' (15.4m x 7.5m) provides an excellent room for wedding receptions, bazaars, luncheons, dinners and dances etc. **The capacity for meetings or dances is 200 and for seated accommodation 125.** Two sets of glazed doors opening out to a paved terrace, extending the full length of the hall, will permit you to take advantage of favourable weather.

**The Jones Room** 19'6"x13' (6m x 4m) will accommodate 40 people to gather informally or 25 seated in tastefully furnished and decorated ambience. There is a servery with glazed doors to the foyer and kitchen enabling the room to be used either to complement the main hall as a cloakroom or reception area for the larger gatherings or accommodate smaller business or private meetings or dinner parties.

**Kitchen** 18'x13'6" (5.6m x 4.2m) has been designed to provide local Meals-on Wheels service and is extremely well equipped and ideal for those larger wedding receptions and dinners. A servery with stainless steel work top opens into the main hall. All hirers must appreciate that in the event of both rooms being booked by different groups that they are expected to share the kitchen facilities - the hall Administrator will help in liaising in such circumstances.

**Transport** to and from the hall is normally via Cavendish Road which leads from the northern end of the High Street but buses and coaches must access the premises via Buckwood Road (adjacent to the Fire Station in the centre of the Village) and take the first turning on the right (Cowper Rise) and bear to the left along Cowper Road. Adequate parking is available.

**Booking Arrangements** -Markyate Village Hall is available for all suitable functions but the Management Committee have the right to refuse bookings if they feel that there is a risk to the well being of the Hall. Concessionary rates are available and these are described in the following categories:

Category A: Markyate based Non Profit Making Organisations & organised groups of Pensioners

Category B: Residents and Business Establishments of Markyate and Non Profit Making Organisations outside Markyate

Category C: Persons or Business Establishments not located within the Parish
